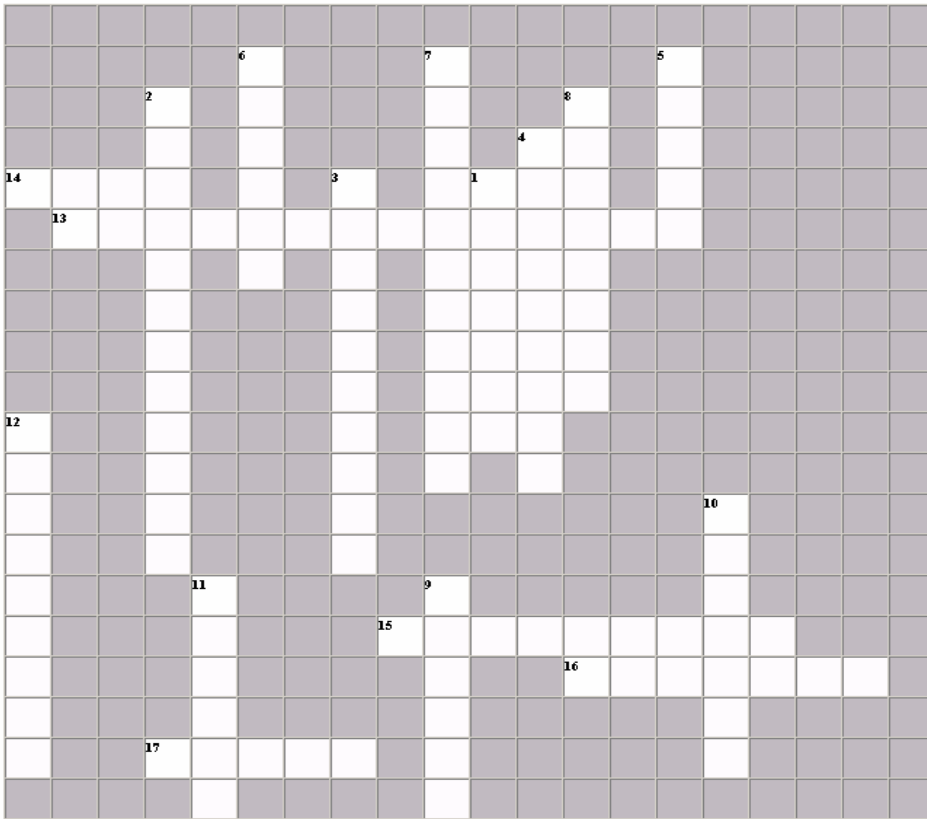

THE ANNUAL CHRISTMAS DINNER DANCE

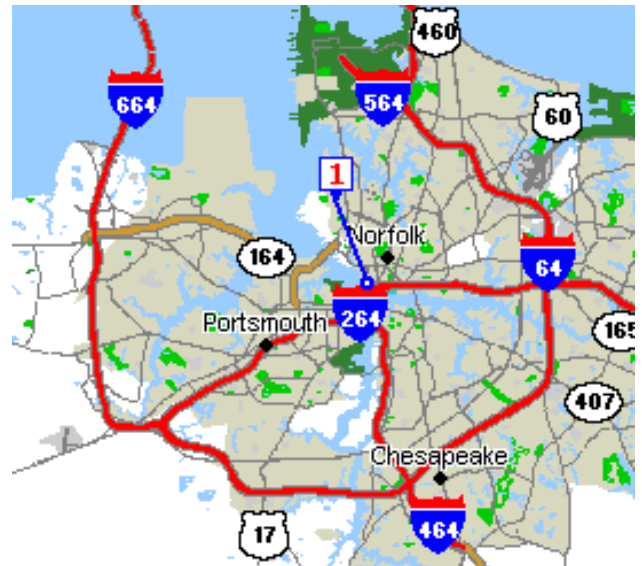
Saturday December 4th, 2004
